OBJECTIVES (Layunin)

1. To deepen and strengthen our commitment as responsible stewards of God’s creation by studying, praying and living the teachings of Laudato Si!
(Magkaroon ng mas malalim at matibay na pagtalaga sa sarili bilang tunay na katiwala ng Diyos sa pamamagitan ng pag-aaral, pagdarasal at pagsasabuhay ng turo at aral ng Laudato Si.)
2. To develop a liturgy on the celebration of Creation Time/Season of Creation that will connect faith and care for God’s creation and the poor.
(Maka buo ng Liturhiya para sa pagdiriwang ng Panahon ng Paglikha upang maiugnay ang pananampalataya sa pangangalaga sa Sangnilikha ng Diyos at mga nangangailangan .)
3. To encourage concrete actions in solidarity with all Christian faithful and all sectors to stop all kinds of environmentally destructive activities that especially undermines the poor and our common home.
(Mahikayat kumilos at makiisa sa lahat na Kristiyanong mananampalataya at mga batayang sektor upang pigilan ang iba’ibang uri ng mapanirang proyekto na nagdudulot ng tuluyang pagkawasak ng kinabukasan ng mga susunod na henerasyon.)
